- Definition: A spiritual gift is a significant ability given to each believer by the Holy Spirit, who in this way equips and moves members of the church to serve others in special ways for Christ and his kingdom.
- Different between spiritual gifts and talents: A talent is often mistaken for a Spiritual gift. These abilities are independent of our accepting Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior. Talent is "any natural ability or power; natural endowment.
- Facts about spiritual gifts: They are freely and graciously given. So there is no place for pride. They are given to serve, not to be served, in the body of Christ.
- Purposes of spiritual gifts: To build up the body of Christ, the Church; To serve others; To glorify the Lord.

Definition of the gift of teaching

	The gift of teaching is the ability to communicate the information in such a way that the members of the body of Christ understand how to apply the word of God to their own lives and ministries so that they may be built up, unify and mature in the body of Christ to be Christ's witnesses in word and deed in this world.
